To Our Shareholders, Clients, Partners, and Associates:

Our technology came to life each day as our software products assisted growing numbers of healthcare providers in improving the lives of their patients. Increasing numbers of physicians used NextGenem and NextGenem to enhance patient outcomes and practice economics. The wide range of services provided by our EDI/ Connectivity unit brought technology to the many interactions that form the day-to-day fabric of our nation's healthcare system. The QSI Division's dental practice management software and Clinical Product Suite are examples of technology that brightened the smiles of dental clients and their patients.




